Oil adsorbent booms are created at Allouette Correctional Centre for Women



Chemicals are removed by filtration or high-heat incineration in the closed loop smelting process



Through a centrifugation process, the liquid portion is spun out and neutralized into salts and water and can return to the waste water stream



Booms can be donated for oil spills



The waste is either neutralized in a storage tank or used to create additional energy



The solid components that contain chemical compounds, including lead acetate, are diverted to a landfill designated for hazardous waste
