



Key Facts about each Operator for your Clipper commute:



Available Passes: Adult 31 Day Local Pass, Adult 31 Day TransBay Pass, RTC Local Calendar Pass

Special Notes: ACT Passes are valid for 31 consecutive days after first tag



Available Products: BART HVD 45/48 or BART HVD 60/64

Special Notes:

- Adult cards must have a min of \$1.95 e-cash
- You can only choose 1 HVD ticket denomination, a combination of the two is not allowed
- The card will load the entire HVD value all at once.
- You may order up to (3) 60/64 HVD passes or (5) 45/48 HVD passes at one time
- Max value loadable on card is \$250
- The order will not load to the card until there is sufficient room (new order + existing balance <\$250)



Available Passes: Almost all existing Caltrain products are available on Clipper

Special Notes:

- Requires \$1.25 in cash in order to have Caltrain pass or ridebook on card
- MUST tag to load monthly pass by the 15th of current month
- MUST tag on and off to calculate correct fare if using cash value
- Caltrain 8 ride books expire after 30 days
- Multiple 8 ride books, up to 3 at a time can be purchased. You must select to “place one time order” for each ride book
- If you are using an 8-ride book from Zone 1 to Zone 4, you must tag on and off in Zone 1 or Zone 4, meaning you cannot tag on or off in Zone 2 or 3, otherwise you will get charged the full cash fare
- Monthly Parking Permit is available for purchase at Caltrain station ticket vending machines by entering Clipper card #.



EAST BAY OPERATORS



Available Passes: East Bay Regional Local 31-Day Pass, East Bay Regional Express 31-Day Pass, Tri Delta Transit 31-Day Pass, WestCAT 31-Day Pass, Wheels 31-Day Pass

Special Notes:

East Bay Regional Local and Regional passes can be used on all 4 operators

- Requires \$1.75 in cash value on the card in order to pay for a ride using cash
- EB Regional Local and Express 31-Day Pass can be used on all regular and express routes except routes 250, 260 and Alamo Creek Shuttle
- WestCAT 31-Day Pass can be used on all WestCAT routes except the local portion of the Lynx route
- Wheels 31-Day Pass can be used on all All Wheels routes

MARIN COUNTY OPERATORS



Available Passes: None. Only cash is accepted

Special Notes: Golden Gate Ferry accepts *only* Clipper as fare payment

- Golden Gate Transit requires a minimum cash value balance of \$4.20 on your Clipper card to ride the ferry
- Marin Transit accepts Clipper card on all routes except Muir Woods Shuttle (route 66/66F)



Available Passes: Adult Fast Pass (includes travel on BART), Muni Only Fast Pass, Senior Fast Pass, RTC Fast Pass

Special Notes:

- If you have an existing Muni Pass on the card the new pass will load after the grace period ends once card is tagged on the 4th of each month
- MUST tag to load the pass by the 16th of current month
- Muni Fast Passes and cash are accepted on cable cars
- The handheld devices will allow conductors to deduct cash from the Clipper Card and will load the passes and other products purchased via the web or phone

Napa / Solano County Operators



Available Passes: 31 Day passes

Special Notes: Rolling passes DO NOT have grace periods. They expire after midnight on the 31st day from initial tag.

- You must have a 31 Day pass or a minimum cash value of \$6 on an adult or youth card and \$5.50 on a Senior or RTC card
- You must tag on and off with each ride
- FAST does not accept Clipper for Short Hop Fares on SolanoExpress Route 30 and Route 40
- VINE accepts Clipper for payment on Route 29 to BART, but not for Router 20 to the Vallejo Ferry Terminal

Sonoma County Operators



Available Passes: 31 Day passes

Special Notes:

- Requires \$1.50 in cash value on the card in order to pay for a ride using cash
- You must tag on and off with each ride



Available Passes: Adult Local Monthly Pass, Adult Local SF Monthly Pass, Youth Monthly Pass, Senior/RTC ED Monthly Pass

Special Notes:

- MUST tag on a SamTrans vehicle by 15th of current month to load pass
- SamTrans Day pass is not available on Clipper



Available Passes: Standard Monthly Pass, Express Monthly Pass-Adult, Standard Monthly Pass- Youth, Senior, RTC

Special Notes:

- MUST tag on a VTA vehicle by 15th of current month
- VTA offers one free single ride regular fare credit for customers transferring to VTA from the following transit systems:
 - AC Transit (includes Dumbarton Express Service)- within 2 hours of boarding AC Transit
 - BART (Fremont station only)- within 1 hour of exiting the station
 - SamTrans (monthly pass holders only)- within 2 hours of boarding SamTrans
- Caltrain Monthly passes for two or more zones for Adults and Youths and one zone for Senior/Disabled passengers are valid on all VTA Local and Limited Stop Buses, Light Rail and Historic Trolley



Available Passes: None. Only Cash is accepted

Special Notes: Accepted on the following routes. South San Francisco/Alameda/Oakland, Alameda Main Street/Oakland/San Francisco, Alameda Harbor Bay/San Francisco, and Vallejo/San Francisco

- Requires \$1.50 in cash value on the card

BICYCLING

Clipper Direct does not offer bicycling benefits at this time.

PARKING

Clipper Direct does not offer parking benefits at this time. We plan to offer parking by Summer 2016
