About the Committee

Created via [ordinance \(PDF\)](#) on April 23, 2012 and codified in Chapter 26 of the Borough Code, the Sustainable Madison Advisory Committee of the Borough of Madison is an eleven member committee charged with encouraging sustainable practices in the Borough of Madison. With 900 points, Madison is the Sustainability Champion for mid-sized Communities for 2021, the highest number for municipalities between 5,000 and 40,000 people, and second highest overall. To maintain our Sustainable Jersey certification, Madison's Green Team – the Sustainable Madison Advisory Committee – completes an online application at a minimum of every three years, documenting sustainable actions in the Borough. These actions fall into several major categories, ranging from energy to food, waste, natural resources, building, transportation, health, water, and community education and outreach. The Green Team works closely with Borough staff, officials and committees, and with other organizations in town to encourage, support, initiate and report on sustainable actions and practices.
